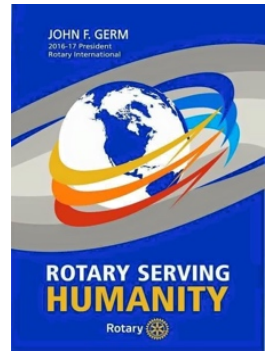

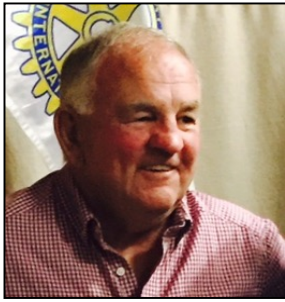

# Billy's Blog

Great to see a strong representation from all service clubs at our combined meeting last week. A lovely meal and some valuable fellowship made it a most enjoyable night.

This week we have Jennifer Garrison from the Docklands Rotary Club talking to us about a portable dental chair project she and her club have been involved with. Jennifer and her friend from Gooram helped us out on the open garden days earlier this year.

This week I am going to use my blog for a plea for help for a young local family who are going through a tough period at the moment. **Steven Jeffery** was a guest speaker at one of our meetings last year.

As most of you will know Steven is now fighting an acute form of leukaemia. He has undergone a lot of difficult treatment in the past 6 months including chemotherapy and a bone marrow transplant. The next part of Steven's treatment is a stem cell transplant. He will be placed in an isolation ward at the Royal Melbourne Hospital for approximately 6 weeks and once again he will be separated from his wife and two very young children.

This is a physically and emotionally difficult phase of his treatment but it is an essential part of dealing with this life threatening illness. A special bank account has been set up to help the Jeffery family cover the costs of their massive medical bills, accommodation in Melbourne etc.

This is definitely a family that needs the support of their local community. Please help by donating to the Steven Jeffery Donation Fund at the Commonwealth Bank in Euroa. You can donate by making a direct payment at the bank or by making an online transaction. **The BSB number is 063682. The Account number is 10162724.** There is also an online "Go Fund Me" account that you can donate to. Cheques can also be mailed to Rodwells in Euroa (Steven's workplace) and the staff will deposit the cheques at the Commonwealth Bank. Please contact Kerrie for information or assistance. Please give generously as financial stress is one thing that families in this position can definitely do without. Thank you.
