Thursday Night's meeting

Lucas Paul, Victorian Police, Euroa Station, presented to the club on drugs and other issues. He told us about the Cool Heads driving programs in schools for 16 to 17 year olds. This, in addition to the cancelation of the police program in primary schools has, in his opinion, has had impact on the as yet unpublished implication of drugs in the road toll. He gave us background information on methamphetamines in various forms as it seen on the streets illegally and the risk taking, unpredictable behaviour of drug takers. There was also a discussion on how to get past the blockers that prevented readily applied roadside drug testing and screening, including the cost which could be around \$65 per test. He is keen to be involved a forum to be undertaken soon with the community,

Perhaps we should think about the follow up to this including the tests which are currently available but expensive.
