Michael Tehan spoke on Thursday night to club members and guests about Capacity, Powers of Aterney and Wills. He said one of the most important issues to deal with first is to establish is the person understands what is going on and what they are doing in succession planning. He explained that there are 2 Powers of Atterney, one being for medical treatment and the Enduring Power of Attorney which includes guardianship, lifestyle and financial. Changes were made as to what happens if someone dies without a will from November 1 this year. "Things can go wrong when you do your own will, however, a will is much better than no will at all" Get good advice, that's the bottom line.
