## Thursday's Meeting

Dennis Rebbeck explained that he has been sponsoring a family in Bali since 1996 primarily to send the children to school and university. He met the primary income earner at a Travel Expo in Adelaide when was involved in the travel industry. They

became friends and he started the sponsorship. This developed into the building of a house to replace the one room building they lived in. Photos went through the process from demolition to final building. Dennis explained the changes this meant to the 3 families (8 people), like having a cooking area inside, water proof roof, shower and toilet.

It was interesting to hear about their culture, especially the private nature of the family and how visitors are entertained outside on what we would call a veranda. The Balinese are really reliant on the tourism industry, which still is suffering from the bombing.

Dennis is flying out to Bali on Monday to buy a block of land in another part of the island for \$20,000 so that he can help another family to build a house. We saw the design of this two-storey house and he suggests that the cost of the build will be about \$50,000.

Dennis is positive that his sponsorship has made and is still making a significant difference to these families. The parent has improved his vocational status and the children are going to university.

Dennis's address was truly amazing.
