The next Vocational Services event is a visit to the new winery and cellar door facility developed in Seymour by Sam Plunkett and his wife Bron Dunwoodie. Known as Wine by Sam, the winery previously operated in leased facilities at Elgo Estate located at Upton Hill. In relocating the winery, Sam purchased and undertook a major redevelopment of a disused dye works in Anzac Parade, Seymour.

Sam will give us a tour of the facility and describe how he produces his wines, the way his business has evolved, the challenges of setting up his own premises and why he chose Seymour as the location.

### **The Long Road from a Broken Heart**

An inspiring presentation from our guest speaker Jeremy Scott who couldn't tell the whole story about his bike ride from London to Auckland, but gave some great stories with plenty of humour and a small selection of wonderful slides.

He was born with a hole in the heart and had it operated on when he was 4 years old and became an ordinary child. He travelled and saw most of the world but still needed a challenge. While living in London in 2011 he decided to ride home to Auckland and raise money for Heart Foundation.





While there were good and bad encounters, just meeting people and learning of their culture, inspired him to keep going.



A turning point in his life occurred in Asia. Having a drink with a chap (Warren) in a bar, he wanted to know what he was doing, so Jeremy told his story. Warren said the name of the surgeon and explained that his brother had been operated on by the same person but had not survived the operation, 2 years earlier than Jeremy's

operation. From that point on Jeremy has dedicated his life to raising money for charities.
