Jan Griffiths addressed the meeting explaining Home Care Packages and Advance Care Planning. Statistics show that Euroa has the highest population of elderly in the state. Added to this is the fact that other older Victorians are being attracted to the town as well.

Baby Boomers are finding it difficult to navigate the now deregulated Aged Care Industry, which used to be provided by a monopoly given to only a few providers. Now the client can have a say as to how their funds can be spent, the system is now based on client allocated funds. Many are confused about accessing an Aged Care Package. Jan says that people are required to register on My Aged Care on line, which can be difficult for those over 65. There are 4 levels of care determined by an assessment. It is all about maintaining people's independence for as long as possible.

Advanced Care planning promotes care that is consistent with an individual's goal, values, beliefs and preferences. It is a way of preparing for future health care, for a time when we may no longer be able to communicate those decisions ourselves. It is a legal document.
