John Heal and Bill Sargood

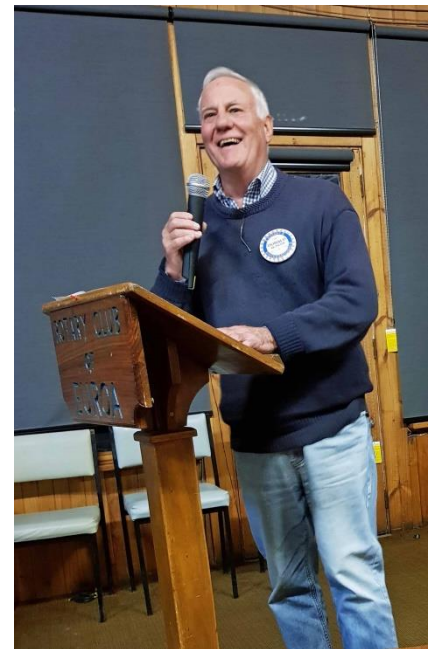
Our intended guest speaker was ill, so President Richard requested John and Bill to provide accounts of their recent heart surgery experiences.
