It is a thought provoking and informative road safety program with advice on a wide range of topics for young drivers.



An update on Emily, Lyn Newnham's daughter, who was injured in a car accident on Friday, July 20 as messaged by Lyn last week:

"Em is still in an induced coma, she has pneumonia and high temperature which has slowed progress. Right now she is being moved to the Austin Hospital in Heidelberg because they are the spinal experts. Emily has fractured her spine in 2 places, base of skull and T4 (T4 is spinal cord damage also causing lower limb paralysis, probably permanent) a broken clavicle and 6 broken ribs. Head trauma with a gash at her hairline and top of head. She is still in ICU until the breathing tube is removed. And we will not know any more until she is awake, even then the pain medication may be so high that we will not get a clear idea for a while. But she will be at the Austin for months for rehabilitation." Thank you all for your kind wishes, Lyn.
