The Roy Orbison evening at BPAC in October has to be decided upon at the next meeting.

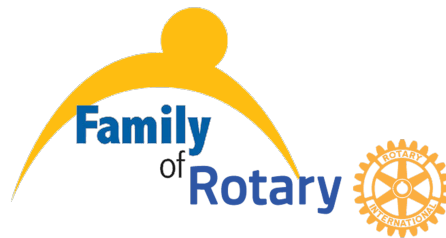
