Friendlies Oval Development

Rotarian Peter Morley gave members an update on the slow development of the Friendlies Oval following some discussion and concern as the club and community have contributed to the project. He outlined the following:

- There are no further monies required from Rotary for the completion of the Friendlies
- We are holding over \$60k in a trust account named "Rotary Club of Euroa Friendlies Reserve Development Account"
- The above account is a trust account and the club treasurer receives a copy of the account
- No monies have been used or will be used from the above account until Rob Asquith and I agree that the Council have completed their obligation to the project
- The project will be completed however, the timing is out of our control, it is in the hands of the council
- We have on top of the \$55k a further \$5k for the building of a Machinery Shed donated by Freemasons Euroa Branch which gives us the \$60k
- We have held discussions with Ian Ball of The Falls re landscaping the Friendlies and surrounding area and he prepared preliminary drawings and is positive to be involved
- Latest email today states that wicket area, ground and irrigation should be completed by end of August and fence constructed during September and seeding oval when weather is ok
