

The Business Breakfast was also a good opportunity to network and there was some positive discussion about potential sites for our proposed Community Garden. Presenting A Flying Life to the club on Thursday night, Mark Carr, of Creighton's Creek, told of his career and explained that he has been flying all his life. He joined the Navy when he was 16, he found the pilot's course very demanding. Mark showed lots of photos of planes he has flown, describing the experience and comfort of each, while also noting the changes in the technology which occurred throughout his career. He said he was young and stupid when he started out. He then took on the role of a trainer himself when the Navy and Air Force trainers joined together, then he became a member of the Air Force. He told us that at aged 29 he was about to be promoted out of flying and he didn't want that. First he flew for Ansett for 2 years flying their Friendship and Fokker aircraft. He then moved on to Cathay Pacific as the dispute with Ansett, "not a pleasant time at all", and he flew for Cathay for the next 23 years, 16 of which were out of Hong Kong. Mark and his wife, Yvonne, are now enjoying retirement, he is involved in the Benalla Aviation Museum and runs Adventure Flights in restored historic Military Training Aircraft.
