Thursday Night's Meeting

Tim Goodacre, chair, and Sissy Hosking, executive officer from Go Nagambie were our guests at this week's meeting. Go Nagambie is an initiative to promote the town as a destination as a place to come to visit, stay a while and spend some money. Tim said that Go Nagambie is a tremendous model which can be replicated by other towns. Tim said Nagambie is a great place to live but prior to this campaign no one knew where it is! 2000 people live in the town but during the summer population swells to 10,000.

Several meetings were called, inviting the whole community and the message was clear...we need your help to get this initiative up and running. They engaged a media firm and that required money. Once they were on board and had a look at what Nagambie had to offer, they said, "This is going to be an easy sell!". They needed a plan and they needed money. In suggesting that Euroa could adopt the model, Tim said you need someone who will drive the effort. "We didn't want all the money to come from the high flyers in the town, we wanted everyone to have a buy in toward the plan. The campaign promotes the lifestyle and liveability of the area. Strong governance is required, "If you are going to ask for money, you need to look professional, and this structure means you can attract more government funding. Tim said they are happy to share all the information they paid lots of money to procure. The evening was attended by several business people in Euroa.
